Alfred Adler (1870–1937): Individual Psychology Adler called his approach individual psychology because it expressed his belief that every human personality is unique and indivisible (Ewen, 1988) His emphasis on the individual did not preclude the social

psychology for his approach in order to emphasize the indivisible (undivided or whole) nature of our personalities and refer to the essential unity of the individual psyche Adlerians focus on

Individual Psychology (cont) Alfred Adler Childhood disease—rickets (made him clumsy and awkward) When younger brother born, mother shifted her affections Watched brother die in next bed Brushes with death (run over twice, pneumonia) Briefly associated with Vienna Psychoanalytic society Never psychoanalyzed Dissented with Freud from the beginning
